TRANSPORTATION (as submitted by Hospital Chairman)

Driver to any Shriners Hospital (each day) -----	100 points
Co-Driver to any Shriners Hospital (each day) -----	100 points
Lawton Driver (each day) -----	50 points
Van maintenance (each day) -----	50 points

STATED SESSION

Attending Potentate Called Stated Session (as documented in Shrine Center's sign-in book) -----	25 points
Attending Ceremonial Session -----	25 points
Attending Potentate Called Unit & Club Head Meeting -----	25 points
Attending other Potentate approved group meeting -----	25 points

PARADES

Attending India Potentate approved parade ----- (includes parades for Akdar, Bedouin, etc. if approved by Potentate in that jurisdiction and India Potentate)	50 points
Attending CSSA sponsored parade -----	50 points
Attending Imperial or other association sponsored parade ----- (other association is defined as any other regional or state group - Texas, Southern, etc.)	100 points

CIRCUS

General setup for India Shriners prior to Circus ----- (as submitted by Manager of activity and does include Potentate's hospitality room, banners, entrance curtain, novelties, etc.)	100 points
Working Circus performance (per show) ----- (as submitted by Director's Staff sign-in records)	35 points
Sales for each \$100.00 in Buck-a-Lines, banners, tickets, etc. ----- (as submitted by Shrine Office and does not include time spent on activity or expense)	25 points
General teardown for India Shriners after the Circus ----- (as submitted by Manager of activity and does include Potentate's hospitality room, banners, entrance curtain, novelties, etc.)	100 points

TEMPLE WORK

These activities must be unpaid non-fundraising type activities.

Meritorious Service to the Nobility of India (Potentate's discretion) -----	100 points
Packaging gifts for Shrine patients (per day) -----	50 points
Preparing mail for delivery (per day) -----	50 points
Promotional programs & presentations representing the Shrine or Hospitals -----	50 points
Hospital Children's and Shrine Children's Christmas Parties	
Setup prior to Christmas Party (each) -----	50 points
Working Christmas Party (each) -----	50 points
Tear down & cleanup after Christmas Party (each) -----	50 points
India sponsored visits to the infirm and ill -----	10 points
Any other activity in, around, or for the Shrine or Hospitals (up to 4 hours) ----- (subject to Potentate's discretion but can include email notices, website, delivery, set up, tear down, etc.)	25 points

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APPLICATIONS (top line signer only)

New Noble for India -----	100 points
New Affiliate or restoration of Noble for India -----	50 points
New Brother or restoration of Brother for Masonic Lodge -----	50 points
New Scottish Rite, York Rite, or restoration of Rite Mason -----	50 points
New patient accepted into hospital program (as submitted by Hospital Chairman) -----	100 points

DEGREE TEAM

Participation in the conferring of Shrine or Masonic degrees ----- (actual participation in conferring of degree required - not attendance of degree)	50 points
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CSSA (other association is defined as any other regional or state group - Texas, Southern, etc.)

Participation in CSSA association meeting -----	50 points
Participation in CSSA competition -----	50 points
Participation in Imperial or other association meeting -----	100 points
Participation in Imperial or other association competition -----	100 points

OTHER

This category shall only be used for events and activities NOT covered by any of the above categories.

Fundraising with 100% India Shriners benefit (for each \$100) -----	25 points
Point updates, reinstatements, Divan service, etc. as needed -----	?? points

GENERAL RULES

1. All Unit Heads, Club Heads, or other Managers of point worthy activities are responsible for point submission. They may delegate this activity but must still supervise to assure it is being done.
2. All potential point worthy activities for the benefit of the Shrine or Hospitals not previously defined in this document are encouraged to be submitted for point consideration.
3. All point worthy activities, except as stated above, must be submitted on a standard Point Sign-Up Sheet or other pre-approved format (i.e., email, list, etc.) as approved by the Points Person.
4. All submissions for point worthy activity must be legible and include activity description, activity date, Noble's name, and Noble's Shrine ID. Any submission not deemed acceptable shall be returned to the author. If the author is not known, the submission shall be posted on the Shrine Center's bulletin board for 60 days in hopes someone on the submission shall return it to the author. If not returned after 60 days, the submission shall be voided.
5. Ladies may not earn points for any Noble.

ACTIVITIES NOT CONSIDERED POINT WORTHY

1. Meetings of Units, Clubs, Divan, or other Masonic organizations.
2. Fundraising activity for the benefit of Shrine members or families, Units, Clubs, or other Masonic bodies even though funds may be subsequently donated to an India Shriners account.
3. Activities not approved by the Potentate.
